BULLETIN BOARD:


The bulletin board at Goose Pond should be monitored to keep notices timely. Les will make a key for Jerry Miller so the notices will be current.

MAIL BOXES AT GOOSE POND:


Jerry Miller feels there is enough interest from residents at Goose Pond to purchase a pedestal postal box unit. He will look into the matter.
